The World Peace Pageant 2012 will be held one day before the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Ceremony, with the motto of "No More Hibakusha (atomic bomb survivor)". This event will appeal the abolition of nuclear weapons, by sending this message toward the rest of the world from here in Los Angeles as well as a peace message of Hiroshima City Mayor.

The title to this year's event is "No More Hiroshima, No More Fukushima!" which means Abolition of Nuclear Weapons and Pull Out of Nuclear Power Plants.

In advanced European countries such as Germany, Italy, Switzerland Belgium and others, the movement of anti-nuclear power plants is rising. In this new movement, the world is watching how Japan will take direction in their energy policy after experiencing two Hibaku, by A-Bombs in 1945 and by disaster of Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant in 2011.

In the United States especially in California, the electrical power generation using alternative energy sources such as the wind power and the sunlight energy have drawn significant attention. With this trend to support the electricity generation without using the nuclear power, it seems that the idea of abolishing the nuclear weapons is a natural result. These two phrases can considered to be synonym.
